A BYLAW OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 49 (CENTRAL COAST) to dispose of Real Property through the grant of a Statutory Right of Way to Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Fisheries and Oceans:

The Board of Education of School District No. 49 (Central Coast), the registered owner of the property hereinafter described, in accordance with Section 65(5) and Section 96 of the *School Act* hereby grants a Statutory Right of Way in favour of Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Fisheries and Oceans ("Her Majesty") over that portion of the property legally described as Parcel Identifier 001-389-157, Lot 2, Section 34, Township 1 and Section 3, Township 2, Range 3, Coast District, Plan 29528, shown outlined in heavy black on a Reference Plan of Statutory Right of Way dated June 8, 2009, certified correct by Ian Robertson, B.C.L.S. and attached as Schedule "A," for the price of \$1,000.00 (One Thousand Dollars).

The Statutory Right of Way is for the purpose of the construction, operation and maintenance of a groundwater well and related infrastructure to service the Snootli Creek Hatchery, which is located on property owned by Her Majesty adjacent to the above-described property.

The Board hereby authorizes the Secretary-Treasurer to execute the Statutory Right of Way Agreement.
