POLICY 130: Board-Superintendent Relations

The Superintendent shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Central Coast Board of Education and is responsible for the professional leadership necessary to translate the will of the Board into administrative action.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for all aspects of school district operations and for duties and powers pertaining thereto as the Board of Education may direct or delegate. The Superintendent may delegate responsibility and the authority necessary to other employees and develop such procedures as is necessary to ensure efficient operation of the schools and the school system.

The Board of Education assumes that the Superintendent is professionally able and possesses outstanding qualities of leadership, vision and administrative skill and that all policies of the Board will be implemented in good faith.

The Superintendent can assume that the Board of Education will respect their professional competence and extend full responsibility for implementation of Board of Education policy decisions. The Superintendent can expect the Board of Education to support decisions and the administration of the school system.
