POLICY 280: Community Use of Facilities

The Board of Education recognizes that school facilities represent a major public investment and should be available for public recreational use to the greatest extent possible. To this end, the Board will enter into joint use agreements with the Central Coast Regional District.

These agreements may provide for the Regional District to schedule all non-school use of school facilities, subject to some restrictions and will provide for School District preference in scheduled use of other community facilities during school hours.
