POLICY 320: Student Activities

The Board of Education of the Central Coast School District (49) believes that student activities at school are a vital part of the total educational program and should be used as a means for developing healthy attitudes and good interpersonal relations, as well as knowledge and skills.

The Board believes that school citizenship, as reflected in student activities, is a measure of the achievement of important school goals. The Board recognizes that the greatest values to be derived from both curricular and extra-curricular activities occur when such activities are developed and encouraged through participation among, or the knowledge of, the student body, interested members in the community and school staff.

Guidelines

1. Any program of student activities should require all student's participation, except extra-curricular activities which shall be on a voluntary basis.
2. Student activity funds should be used for purposes which benefit the student body of the school.
3. The management of student funds is the responsibility of the students with assistance from school system administration.
