POLICY 350: Recognition Ceremonies

The Board of Education of the Central Coast School District (49) believes that with the Provincial examination requirements, graduation standing for most Grade 12 students will not be known until the first week of August. A recognition ceremony at the end of June will acknowledge the culmination of a student's time at Sir Alexander Mackenzie Secondary.

All other activities for the potential graduates, other than the formal recognition ceremony and school sponsored Graduation activities, are to be non-school functions. Neither the school nor the Board of Education recognize, support or in any way are responsible for other activities which may generate from the circumstance of potential graduation, except "Dry Graduation" activities.

Guidelines

1. The Board of Education may, depending upon the availability of funds, and upon the recommendation of the principal, financially assist a recognition ceremony with a grant up to \$500.00 maximum.
2. All other expenses for the recognition ceremony are to be borne by the school or by members of the Grade 12 class.
