#### Annual budget timeline

The annual budget process is from March to June. First draft and Second draft of annual budget are going to be presented at the public board meetings. Final version of annual budget is scheduled to be adopted by the Board in June. Preliminary enrollment forecast for 22/23 is 216. Ministry is going to announce the preliminary operating grant in March.

#### **Capital updates**

Potential capital project list was presented and reviewed with the Board. The suggested top priorities for the summer are BCE new timber shelter, bus shelters at four mile and downtown reserve areas, shearwater water project, SAMS playfield renewal, as well as roof repairs at BCE. These projects are going to be covered under annual facility grant.

Capital funding requests from schools are to be submitted during the annual budget process. The Board is going to review the potential capital projects list based on priorities. Capital funding application is going to be submitted in June.
