## Annual budget 2022/23

Three scenarios of net operating loss were presented. The 1<sup>st</sup> draft of annual budget with \$400k net loss is based on reduction of 3 FTE positions. \$1.2 million accumulated surplus will be expensed in 3 years with proposed \$400k net loss for school year 2022/23.

Operating grant for next school year is going to be decreased by \$100,000. With reduction of budget for services and supplies by \$100,000. \$540,000 operating loss is still anticipated.

## First Nation students' transportation plan/bus route review

The preliminary reports were presented. The consultation meetings are going to be scheduled. Discussion is going to be focused on review of current transportation services to First Nation students and plans for the next school year. BCTEA developed a new template with funding formulas populated. First Nation student transportation fund includes student transportation fund (STF), student location factor fund (SLF) and supplemental student location factor fund (SSLF) and general operating fund.

The district is going to setup meetings with Nation for further discussion.

# Capital updates

Potential capital project list was presented and reviewed with the Board. Funding application for minor capital projects are going to be submitted in June.
