- 4. Uikala language fluency is preferred;
- 5. Be able to read and write the Uikala language;
- 6. Must demonstrate a mature, caring, and dependable attitude;
- 7. Be knowledgeable in Wuikinuxv history especially stories and legends;
- 8. Be knowledgeable in Wuikinuxv protocols dealing with stories, legends, song and dance;
- 9. Required to provide a year plan and thematic cultural unit plans.
